1. Review and comment on draft and existing publications. [G2 - O1, O2]
2. To provide input to EPA on the National Advertising Campaign and other public awareness activities, as requested. [G5 - O1, O2]
3. Provide a liaison to EPA to assist in the establishment of model national construction standards and techniques, as requested. [G5 - O1, O2]
4. Assist EPA in the establishment of standards and policy on radon in water by:
[G5 - O1, O2]
 - a. Attending AWWA workshops/meetings;
 - b. Recommending to CRCPD that the AWWA's Proposed Questions for Consideration by the Radon Technical Group be distributed to radon coordinators as a "heads up" to the nature of the AWWA's activities;
 - c. Provide a committee member to a permanent position on the EPA committee to set guidance for implementation of the SDWAA standard; and
 - d. Meet with EPA decision makers to investigate issues related to important policies related SDWAA.
5. Assist EPA in developing guidance for states on the requirements of the SDWAA through our activities in Charge 4. [G5 - O1, O2]
6. Plan the agenda and assist in the coordination of the National Radon Meeting. [G3 - O3, O4] [G2 - O1, O2]
7. Assist EPA with the development of Uniform Results Reporting Language, as requested. [G5 - O1, O2]
8. To provide liaison for CRCPD with the American Association of Radon Scientists and Technologists (AARST). [G5 - O1, O2, O3]
9. In consultation with other radon professionals in industry and government design a blind testing study of passive radon measurement devices that will provide an indication of the accuracy of passive radon testing devices being utilized by our citizens. Oversee the implementation of the blind testing study and provide a written report of results to the Board of Directors. [G4 - O4]]G5 - O1, O2]
