

## **Staff Contacts for Advance Notification and Arrangements of Radioactive Material Shipment**

Conference of Radiation Control Program Directors, Inc.

Requirements for advance notification, permit, en-route inspection etc. are being imposed by additional state and federal agencies on additional categories of radioactive material shipments. The agencies and staff involved with these requirements and their phone numbers have been changing at 50%/year.

To assist shippers and carriers in complying with these requirements, and to assist regulatory staff in locating each other, CRCPD compiled the following outline of state requirements and associated agency staff.

The long-standing regulations of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) re irradiated fuel, nuclear waste and highway route controlled quantities are given in 10 CFR 71 & 73, available at [www.nrc.gov](http://www.nrc.gov) under Electronic Reading Room, Regulations. Notification requirements are in 10 CFR 71.97, 73.27, 73.72 & 73.73. Contacts at NRC are given in 10 CFR 71.1 and 73.4

Governors's designated recipients of the advance notification required in 10 CFR 71 & 73 are published in the Federal Register annually on or about June 30, [www.gpoaccess.gov](http://www.gpoaccess.gov) Federal Register, Browse, 2005, June 30. In July 2005 the NRC extended its requirements for advance notification and security in transportation to several of the more hazardous radionuclides in shipments of several hundred curies or more. These are below the highway route controlled quantities, and the list will surely change. These requirements were communicated through state radiation control program directors to the licensees in possession of the materials and devices. In case targeted material was missed by these communications, shippers and carriers of material that seems to them to be of relatively great hazard should discuss the proposed shipment with the radiation control authority for the state transited. Vehicle operators and passengers in public transportation who have recently undergone a nuclear medicine procedure should carry a letter from their physician that identifies the nuclide, amount, date of treatment and physician's telephone number.

In public transportation, passengers who carry a device associated with radiation, even an empty container or ratemeter, are being detained under federal security programs. Effective prearrangement by the traveller with each check point along a route is difficult to accomplish. The radiation safety officer for Homeland Security advises travellers to ship such articles by a commercial package service. To expedite cases of detained travellers, the Homeland Security RSO invites calls from security staff re suspicious articles, as do staff in certain other federal agencies listed below.
