Shipments under this special permit may be authorized only by those state radiation control officials who are registered to do so with this office (SP 10656 & 1). The list of these officials is maintained, and updated as necessary, on www.crcpd.org under Radioactive Material Services, Transportation.

Each shipment under the exemption must be reported to the CRCPD Executive Director (E 10656 & 7e). CRCPD received more than 500 shipment approvals under SP 10656 during 2009.

No accident involving cargo under this exemption has been reported to this office.
